2. Report of Activity – 13 years since incorporation! (6/22/91)
 - a. TV ministry has continued to air on cable several times weekly.
 - b. New programs are being taped monthly. Currently ETMACS has 129 programs available for replay, going through the process of selecting which are still current (phone number and address on screen).
 - c. Volunteers are still taping, creating programs, scheduling programs, taking tapes to cable office, and duplicating tapes as requested.
 - d. Audio tapes are being made available upon request.
 - e. Participated in Ministry Faire at Calvary Baptist Church in October 2003. Good exposure and made many contacts.
3. Financial Report
 - a. Donations for 2003 just covered necessary expenses of bank account, post office box fees, and annual non-profit report.
 - b. This year (2003) tax return was filed on time (May 15).
 - c. All blank tapes used in this ministry thus far have been donated.
4. Future plans/ideas – President
 - a. Continue to tape programs and play on cable in Vancouver and Portland, and expand to other cities.
 - b. Plan to reach out to prisons and nursing homes with tape ministry. Contacts with prisons have already been made.
 - c. Planning to expand business of printed material distribution, to publish sermons and other Christian materials. Need additional donations. Next step is to order ISBNs for books to be published.
 1. Currently working on getting “The Meat of the Word for Christians Today” (Books 1 & 2) by Pastor Pride into digital format, making minor revisions and updating copyrights.
 2. Currently working on “Della’s Natural Diabetic Lifestyle” with Della Clare.

 4. Currently creating a database of all 44 printers in United States, to contact with Request for Quote to print books.
